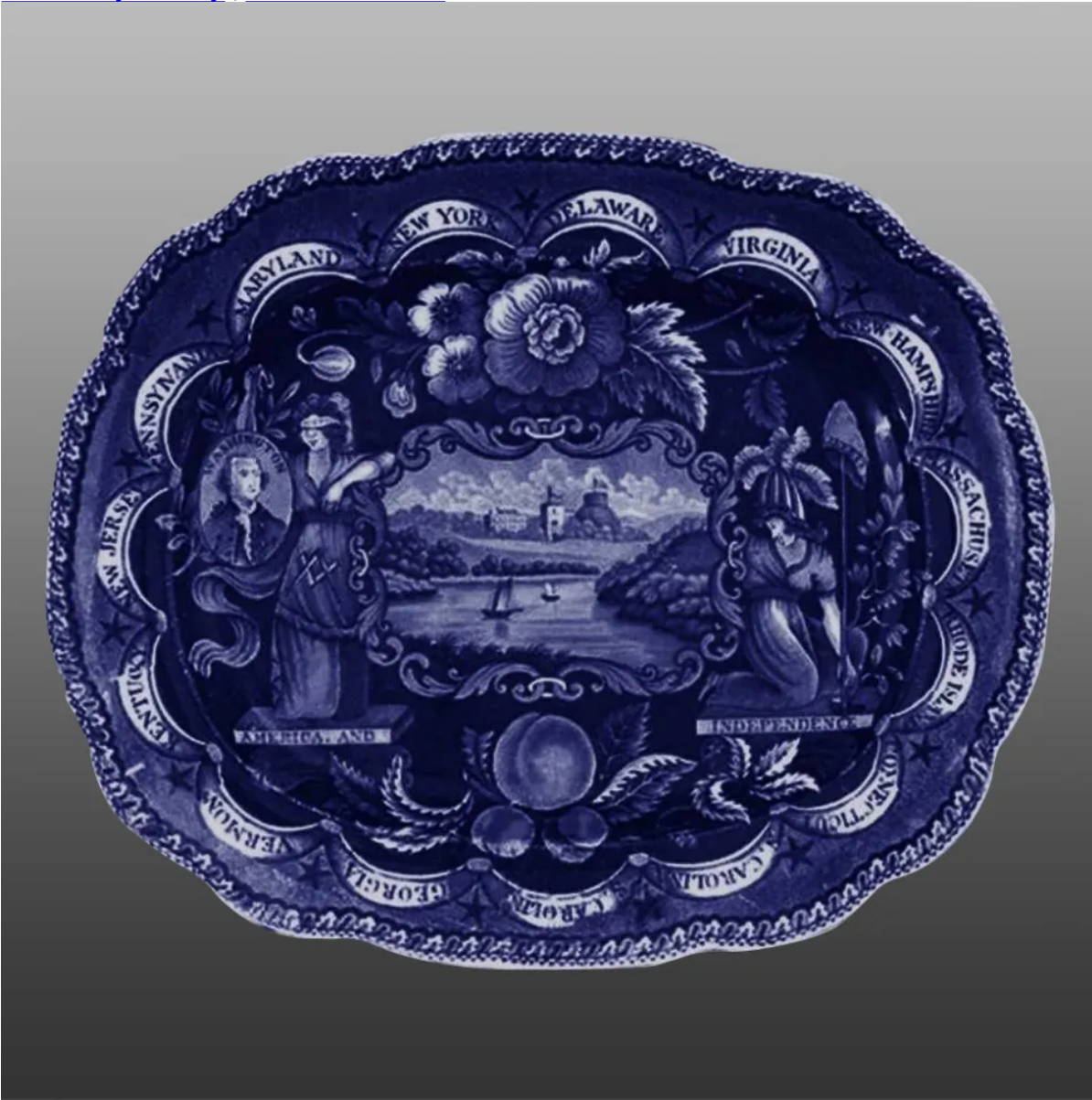

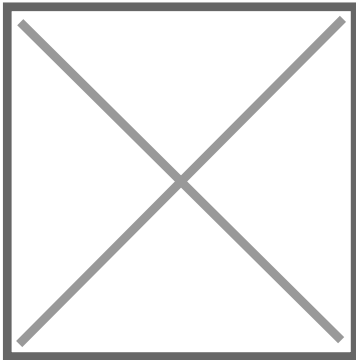

The view printed on this small earthenware platter also appears on many forms: a soup tureen, a pitcher, a handled dish, a washbowl, various sized pitchers, and two sizes of vegetable dishes with their covers. The outer row of states names are on the outer edge. Note that there are 15 states names, representing the first 15 states in the Union. The more common name used
