This Bow straight sided mug is printed in overglaze red with three scenes of children's games: Whip-top (seen here), Blind Man's Buff and Battledore and Shuttlecock, all based on engravings of about 1750 by Jacques Bacheley after designs by Gravelot. The painted floral border is also known on a bowl in the British Museum that is dated 1754.
