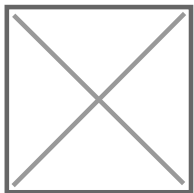

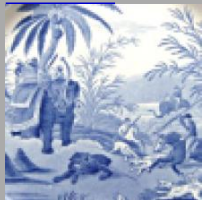
A molded porcelain cake plate in the pattern known as Boy with Spotted Dog. The transfer printing is underglaze, but overglaze enameling completes the pattern.
