Description:

Green bone china tea plate with black printed design. The asymmetrical grouping of the individual elements of the design, together with the subject matter, illustrates the contemporary vogue for all things Japanese. In 1853 trade between Japan and the West reopened and Japanese wares exhibited at the London International Exhibit in 1862 and the World's Fair in Paris in 1867 inspired artists and manufacturers


