

Description:

Earthenware mug, transfer-printed in brown and hand-colored. The design of this mug shows two female figures in classical dress standing before the flags of the signing nations, holding a laurel branch and a cornucopia. The monument at which they stand is surmounted by palm and laurel sprays, and the background depicts peaceful scenes of docks and commerce. The mug is inscribed "PEACE Signed at *expand* [+]
