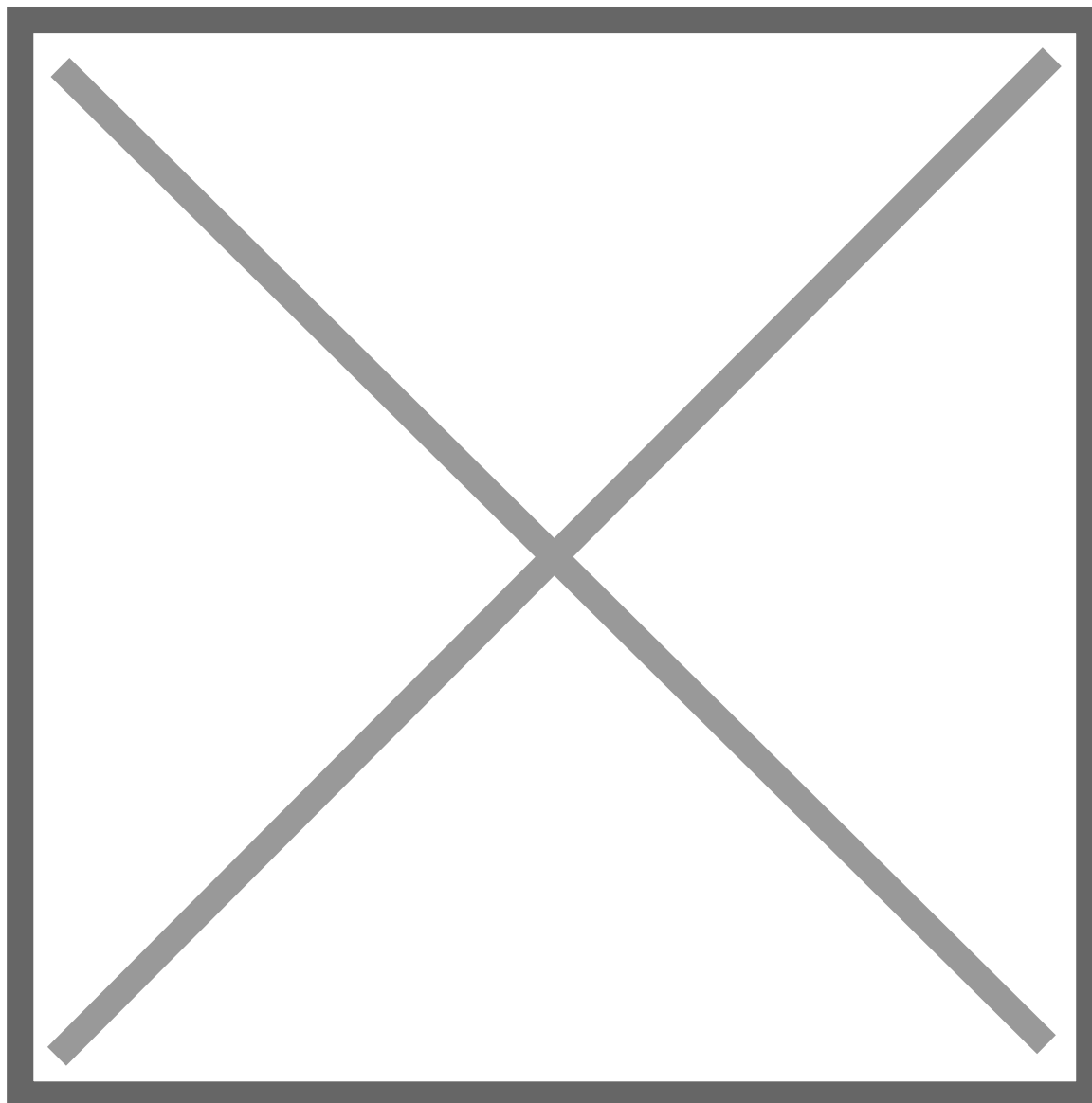

Description:

A dust-pressed earthenware tile, transfer-printed underglaze in black with a design of highland cattle in mountainous country. The design is from one of two series of tiles: *Animals of the Farm* or *Cattle Subjects*. William Wise took the designs from Robert Hills' *Etchings of Animals Drawn from Nature* (1798-1815). Wise was one of a number of designers and illustrators who turned their hand to the design of *expand* [+]
